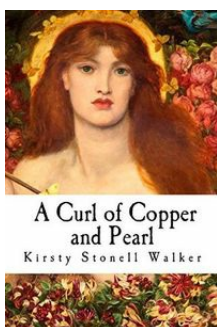


A CURL OF COPPER AND PEARL
