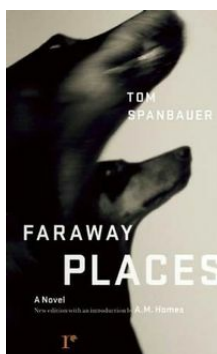


FARAWAY PLACES
