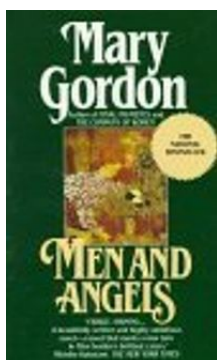


# MEN AND ANGELS
