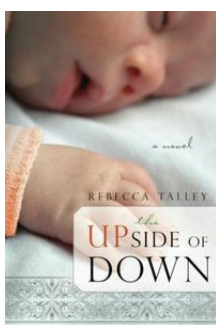


THE UPSIDE OF DOWN
