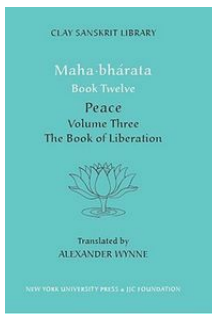


# MAHA-BHARATA BOOK TWELVE, VOLUME 3: PART TWO: THE BOOK OF LIBERATION
