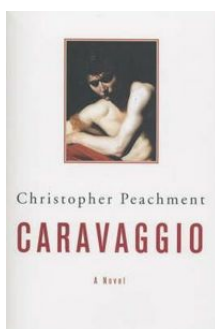


CARAVAGGIO
