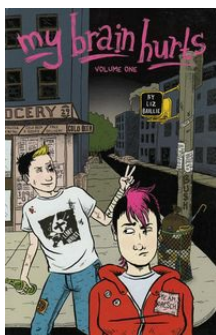


MY BRAIN HURTS, VOLUME ONE
