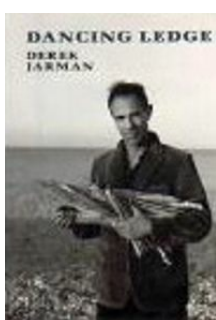


DANCING LEDGE
