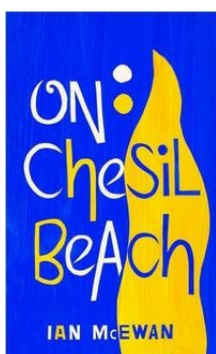


ON CHESIL BEACH
