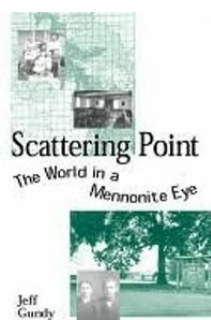


# SCATTERING POINT
